Week of April 2, 2017



Day 1 – Luke 18:1-8

- Are there times in your life when you've felt that you weren't receiving justice? What would it mean for God to grant you justice? Are there people in the world for whom we, as the Body of Christ, need to advocate for justice? What can you do about it?

Day 2 – Luke 18:9-14

- What will it look like for you to live humbly today? Be specific. Ask God for help and guidance.

Day 3 – Luke 18:15-17

- What "little ones" do you tend to ignore or push away? What would it look like for you to welcome and embrace them?

Day 4 – Luke 18:18-30

- Is it possible to be both wealthy and faithful? Knowing that on a global scale we are all wealthy, how are you doing at being faithful with what you have? What might you need to let go of or change to grow in faithfulness?

Day 5 – Luke 19:1-10

- If Jesus were to invite himself to lunch at your house, what would the two of you talk about? What do you think Jesus would want to say to you? How would you respond?
