MY GOAL FOR THE NIGHT |

Have you ever moved to a new community? What was it like? What did you learn about yourself?



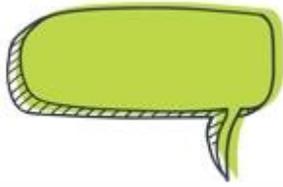
"Tonight we encounter a call for God's people to bring His Family into the world to make the world Our Family. Let's talk about the move!"

- Reread the bottom line. If God comes for us to make us His family, and we move for God, how can moving for God become a way we live our life?



We are compelled to move because we either are forced to move or because we choose to move. In this, we are compelled to move because God has made His Family, Our Family. Our theme is move, because in some way, we need to move in order to share the Good News. Who do you need to share this Good News with in your life? Take a piece of conduit and write the name of that person on the conduit. Take the conduit home as a reminder to be a conduit for Good News to that person!
