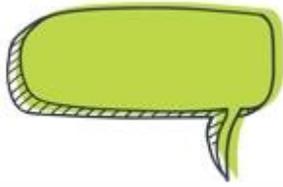
"We need a new filter when it comes to sex/relationships. It's about seeing God's dream for us with how we can love and be loved. Let's talk!"
