Position Description

You will work with the Media Arts Director and a great crew of volunteers who will assist with the many facets of the media arts ministry. Throughout the week, you will coordinate with the Media Arts Director to provide video production, sound, and lighting for worship during the week and other events happening on our campus.

One of the main focuses of the SVPA role will be working with the media team to create videos for weekend worship and special events. In addition, you will collaborate on recording projects, podcasts, and eventually online streaming.

- **Live Sound Support**
 - Run front of house sound for select worship services and events
 - Stage set up and preparation for select events
- **Leadership Development (Year Round)**
 - Work with Media Arts Director, Minister of Worship Arts, Music Staff, and Family Ministry Staff to develop means of recruiting, training, mentoring and retaining volunteers.
 - Continue to grow in your knowledge of technology and how best to use it to advance our mission and ministry

- **Special Events (as needed)**
 - Work in collaboration with relevant Prince of Peace ministries and ministry partners to provide sound, lighting, and video support as needed for children’s choir musicals, seasonal musicals productions, VBS, and Worship Arts Camp.
