We're pleased to announce that our Mission Outpost, Dental Clinic and Child Care construction is nearly complete, and we will begin moving into the new space in early January. A few cosmetic finishes, along with installation of some carpeting, are still needed in order to wrap up the project and will be completed after we move in.

Our dream for this phase of construction was to finally bring the rest of our ministries under one roof: to provide safe, engaging space for Child Care in a centralized location; to provide more space for Mission Outpost, with a welcoming waiting area, office space, and conference rooms to serve our wider community and provide hope and wholeness to people in need; to provide a warehouse with a loading dock for food deliveries, sorting and storage that

increases our capacity to serve those in need; and to build a larger Dental Clinic to provide access to quality dental care for our community.

All of this was made possible through God's goodness and the incredible generosity of this congregation.

Save the date for a Grand Opening event the morning of Sunday, January 23. Tour the new space as we celebrate together! We will be collecting non-perishable food donations for Mission Outpost at the event. Details to come.
