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See It

Look for beautiful things that God has created and say their names out loud.



Hear It

When you hear an animal make a sound (like barking or squawking or mooing) give thanks to God for making that animal.



Talk About It

1. What are some things that you are especially glad God created?
2. What are some ways your family can take care of creation?
3. Talk about your names. Who named you? Do you know why they chose the name for you that they did?
4. Set a timer for one minute and name as many things as you can that God created. Take turns naming and keep count – how many different things can your family name?



Live It

For families to do together: Go for a nature hike or a walk around your neighborhood. Take a bag to collect any litter you see as you go. Make a note of things in nature that you do not know the specific names of – certain flowers or birds or trees. When you get home, do a little research and see if you can learn some new names.

For preschool kids: Plant something like a garden, houseplant, flower, tree, or some herbs. Join God’s creative activity as you plant something new.
