Get It dONE for Families
Daniel 4:1-3

Day One: Read Daniel 4:1-3 – *“to all peoples, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth: Peace be multiplied to you! It has seemed good to me to show the signs and wonders that the Most High God has done for me. How great are his signs, how mighty his wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion endures from generation to generation.”*

- It’s nothing less than a 2500 year old heart transplant story. King Nebuchadnezzar, after witnessing God’s “mighty acts” of preserving Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego from certain death, proclaimed a bold faith in God by saying, “How great are God’s signs, how mighty God’s wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion endures from generation to generation.” Take a few moments today and consider God’s faithfulness to you in your life. Spend a few minutes thanking God for examples of faithfulness in your life. How will you respond to God’s call to be part of the ongoing story at Prince of Peace?

Day Two: Read Matthew 11:28 – *“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.”*

- We’re going to practice gratitude this week as we move through each day. Today we’re giving thanks that God “Gets It dONE” through the people of God everywhere. But specifically we’re celebrating what God is doing in and through Prince of Peace. Take some time to express your gratitude for how God “Gets It dONE” through engaging worship with beautiful, powerful music led by talented, creative musicians that leads us into the heart of God. What commitment will you make to ensure that this continues? What commitment will you make to respond to God’s generosity to you?

Day Three: Read Proverbs 22:6 – *“Train children in the right way, and when old, they will not stray.”*

- Express gratitude today for the ways that God “Gets It dONE” through a congregation that trains young people and sees them NOT as “the church of the future” but equips them to be “the church of the present.” How have you been blessed by the many examples of how our kids lead us? What commitment will you make to the young people who are growing in their faith at Prince of Peace?

Day Four: Read Matthew 18:20 – *“I tell you, if two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them.”*

- Take some time thanking God for the ways that God “Gets It dONE” by teaching, coaching people to enter into the ancient scriptures, to think creatively and critically in ways that illuminate how the Bible still speaks to new generations. Express your gratitude today for the many ways that God “Gets It dONE” by touching the lives of people who gather for weddings, confirmations, community meetings, AA meetings, school district meetings, funerals and memorial services. Pray for those you may know and even those you don’t know who have grown in their faith through these opportunities.

Day Five: Read Matthew 25:34-35 – *“Then the king will say to those at his right hand, ‘Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me.’”*

- Thank God today for a church that “Gets It dONE” by packing millions of meals for starving children around the world and providing food, clothing, dignity, respect, dental care, emotional and spiritual support for people in need right in our midst. How will you be part of the ongoing support of what God is up to in and through Prince of Peace?
