**Day One | Read Psalm 139:13-14**

<sup>13</sup> *You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body  
and knit me together in my mother's womb.*

<sup>14</sup> *Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex!  
Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it.*

- You were created to be you. Give God thanks for making you, YOU!

**Day Two | Read Isaiah 64:8**

<sup>8</sup> *And yet, O Lord, you are our Father.  
We are the clay, and you are the potter.  
We all are formed by your hand.*

- God spent time creating you just right. What is one special gift God gave you in your personality?

**Day Three | Read Matthew 10:29-31**

<sup>29</sup> *What is the price of two sparrows—one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. <sup>30</sup> And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. <sup>31</sup> So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows.*

- Since God knows EVERYTHING about you, even the hairs on your head, what has God revealed to you that makes you unique?

**Day Four | Read Ephesians 2:10**

<sup>10</sup> *For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.*

- You were created for good works; how does that fit into your personality?

**Day Five | Read 1 Peter 2:9**

<sup>9</sup> *But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.*
