LUKE 4:14-30

Jesus went to Nazareth, his hometown. He told the people there that God sent him to proclaim good news to everyone. He told them that the scripture had been fulfilled in their hearing. For a while the people listened, but then they began to grumble. They asked each other, “Isn’t this guy just a kid from the village?” They didn’t like what they were hearing, and they threw Jesus out.

TALK ABOUT THIS:

Do you ever get mad when you hear something you don’t want to hear? Why were these people mad at Jesus? Did Jesus say something upsetting? What?

What did Jesus mean when he told the people that the scripture had been fulfilled when they heard it? Did everyone who was sick or broken suddenly get fixed? Or were the people listening to Jesus supposed to *do* something with the words they heard? What were they supposed to do? How can people fulfill the scripture?
