NEVER GIVE UP ON GOD

>> SEPTEMBER 28

One of the best things we can do when we're facing challenging or difficult circumstances is to call on God. While it can be easy to think that God is distant, verses like this remind us that God is actually closer than we realize ... all the time. All we have to do is call!

To help you keep this truth in mind, memorize this verse. Then, every day this week, use the words in prayer. For example, you could pray, "Dear God, thank you for being near to me when I call on you. Help me be resilient through the truths I learn about you by memorizing scripture. Amen."

What image comes to mind when you think about courage? The idea behind the word courage comes from the word "heart." That means when we gather the courage to do something scary, that bravery comes from our hearts. When we are resilient and push forward through difficult situations, it comes from the courage Jesus has given us in our hearts. When Jesus reminds us here to "take heart," He's basically saying, "Be brave. Be encouraged. I'm the One who will win in the end."

Knowing Jesus is with us and will take care of everything we're facing can give us the motivation and courage we need to keep going!
