We live in a culture of instant gratification. We want to be fulfilled, changed, happy, and comfortable if not now, as soon as possible. It was both terrifying and amazing that Jesus proclaim that the prophet's words of the coming of God's Kingdom would be fulfilled in an instant. For God's Kingdom to come today, means that Jesus and his disruption is ready for us. Today is about more than just the 24 hours. It is a picture of the fact that God's overwhelming, transforming power disrupts what we know, in an instant. We don't have to wait for something else to happen; it's available now because it has been fulfilled in Jesus' coming.


"Jesus took a stand in the temple to proclaim that the word of God has been fulfilled today. Does it mean the disruption can begin right now? Let's talk.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What's something you would hate having to wait for in your life? What about something you wouldn't mind waiting for?
- The story shows us that Jesus was intent on making the coming disruption true today. What else do you need to be true in your life today?
- Jesus quotes several verses from the book of Isaiah. What counts as 'good news' to the poor? What's it mean for captives to be 'set free'? What does "Lord's favor" mean to you?
- "Today" doesn't just mean one day. It means that the disruption Jesus brings is available now. What would you like Jesus to disrupt in your life? What can be "taken hold of" for Jesus' life-changing work?
