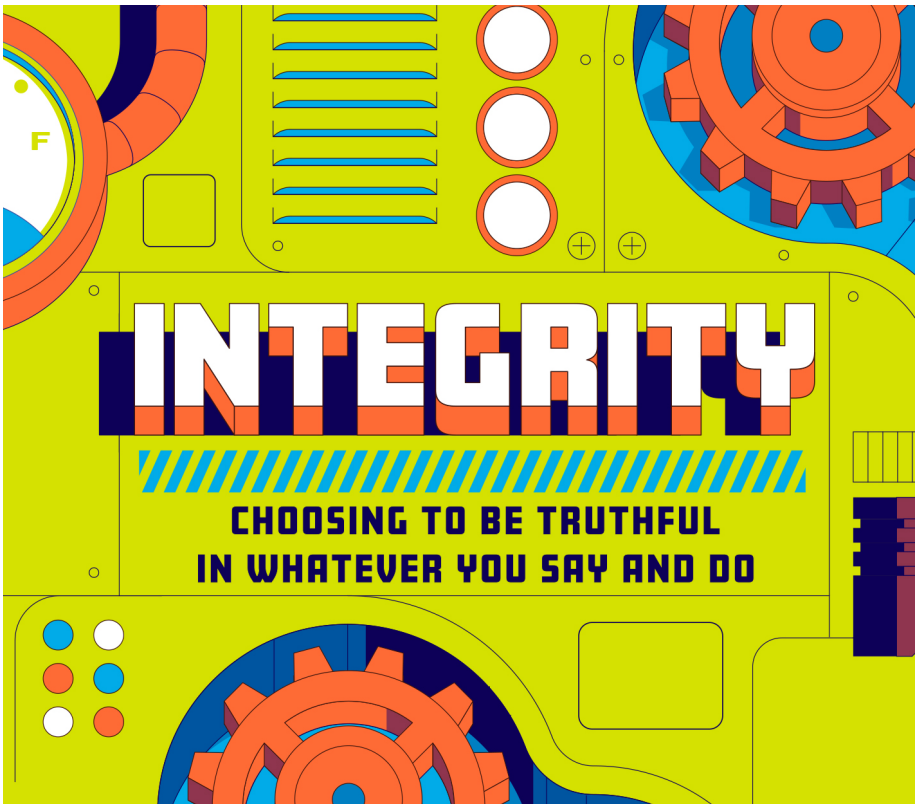

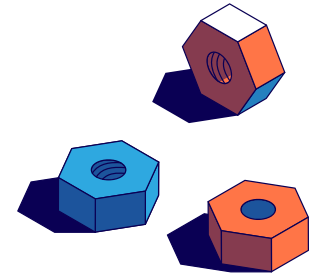
- Thank God for loving You
