Talk About It

3. Can you think of amazing things God is doing for you and/or the world today?
4. Mary's song is a prayer. As a family, try to write a prayer that includes a vision of what God wants the world to be like.

Gather some baby supplies for your community's crisis nursery or foodshelf as a special Christmas gift from your family.
