### BOTTOM LINE

Our God vision shapes our call + response.

### MEMORY VERSE

And God asked, “Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?” And I said, “Here am I. Send me!” Isaiah 6:8 (MSG)

### LIFE APP

Find a way to serve God as a response.

- Students will be challenged to think about their vision of God in the service tonight. What has your picture of God been? Can you share that with your students?

### MY GOAL FOR THE NIGHT |



Everyone has their picture or vision of who and what God is like. It’s informed by church, family, society, friends, books, and especially media. What’s the vision that God gives us in His Word and our experience with Him? Naturally, the vision we experience will shape how we respond to Him. If we see him as a distant, aloof God, we will respond accordingly. Maybe God comes to us in the way He knows we need Him. Maybe He helps us see who He is because of our experiences. It’s more so about bringing an understanding to how we see Him, understanding our call, and then following our response.

### ICEBREAKER

What has been an “awestruck” interaction you’ve had in your life?




“Tonight we experience the story of Isaiah and a picture of his experience with God. Filled with awe, Isaiah answered God’s call. Let’s discuss.”

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What are some popular images of God in pop-culture?
- What is your picture of God? What has shaped your picture of God the most? How has your picture of God changed in your life?
- What do you resonate with in Isaiah’s encounter with God? How would you have responded?
- Isaiah was overcome with awe of God in his vision. When was a time you were in awe of God? (nature) What do you do with the “awestruck” experience? What did Isaiah end up doing?
- Our sense of who we are changes depending on how we see God or other people. Think of meeting someone on the street only to find out they are an undercover officer. Your relationship to them changes. Based on how you see God, how do you see yourself? (friend? Servant? Small?)
- What are some ways we respond to God’s call in our life?
- Sometimes we don’t know how to respond to God. Who can be somebody for us to help us respond to God? Who do you go to?
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Using a piece of butcher paper, draw a giant picture of all the things we think of when we think of God. Talk about how the picture and the pieces of the picture may be true of God, but also discuss how they can change. Leaders, use this as an opportunity to share about how your vision of God has changed over your lifetime.
