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See It

Look at the clouds this week. Think about Moses climbing up a high mountain toward the clouds in order to receive God's commandments.



Hear It

Listen for kind words shared with others. When you hear them, remember how God wants us to treat one another.



Talk About It

1. The Commandments teach us to treat others the way we would like to be treated. Tell a story about a time you did this well.

3. Which of the Commandments is hardest for you to obey?
4. What are some rules we follow at home? Why is it important to follow these rules?

For families to do together: Draw a card from a deck and recite the Commandment that matches the number. If you get a face card, recite a Commandment of your choice.

For pre-k kids: The next time your parent(s) ask you to do something, remember God and say, "Yes, of course!"
