Speak

Scripture tells us that “In the beginning was the word ...”

In John 1:1, God speaks creation into existence:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

In Genesis 1:3, God speaks freedom to the enslaved:

Then God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.

In Exodus 2:24-25, God speaks hope, love, and accountability to a new nation of people:

God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. God looked upon the Israelites, and God took notice of them.

In Exodus 6:7, God speaks truth to power, reorienting history. Redeeming. Restoring. Speaking resurrection and new life:

I will take you as my people, and I will be your God. You shall know that I am the Lord your God, who has freed you from the burdens of the Egyptians.

God has not stopped speaking to us – in our time, in our reality – using the ancient words of the prophets, the seers, the unexpected, and even the forgotten, to guide us. We call out for God to speak: to speak **to** us, to speak **through** us, to speak **for** us, and to speak us into **new life**.
