From Pastor Paul Dean’s sermon:

Jesus spends lots of time away from people, in wilderness areas or places where he can be alone, usually right after or right before large healing or teaching events. Jesus takes time to center his spirit so that he can truly be present with those who need him to be present.

In my time walking this earth I have found this type of behavior to be the hardest thing for many of us human beings to do. To shut down a bit, to find a center. Odds are that many of us, while physically present, are mentally or spiritually somewhere else. Many of us are in desperate need of intentional time with God. How can you carve out that time, and protect it?

Here is a modified version of the Daily Examen, a practice that I use to center myself. I have changed some of the flow and the questions, but the point of centering prayer isn’t to do it a particular way. It’s to find a way for you carve out time with God, and God is ready. In this way, may God center us through our prayers so that we can be present.

- 1. Become aware of God’s presence.
- 2. Review your day with gratitude.
- 3. Look toward the rest of your day with these questions:

What worries you about the rest of the day?
Hold that tight in your fist – and then let it go, remembering that God is present with you.

What are you looking forward to?
Breathe that in, celebrating that God is present with you.
