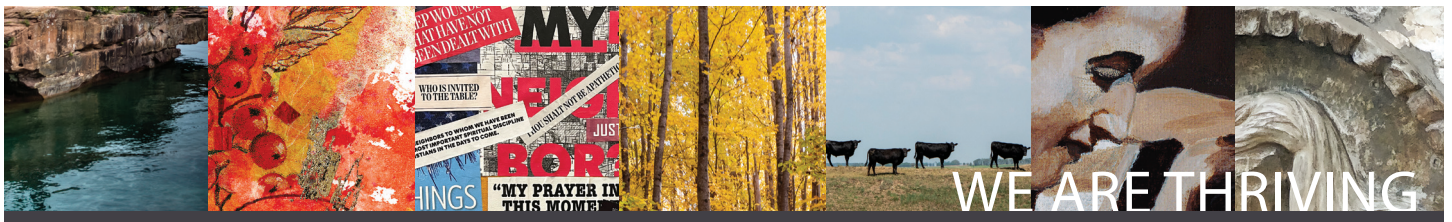

Easter is the announcement that we can reframe ourselves, no matter what. Difficult turning points go hand in hand with the the power of resurrection. Just because we struggle, are challenged, or experience great adversity doesn't mean that resurrection is not at work.

When we ask deeper questions about who we are, what we're doing here, where we're going, and how we'll get there, we begin to consider how challenges are often catalysts for new life. We can learn to reframe how we understand our identity, our purpose, our vision, and our mission as Christ-followers wherever we live and work, wherever we play and go to school, wherever we shop and work out, wherever we drink coffee or tea, wherever we have meaningful conversations with others.

What would really happen if you began to think that way? How would your life be just a little different if you made a fresh commitment to be the hands and feet of the resurrected Jesus in the world? What if you made a conscious decision to bring some focused attention to how thriving rhythms could unfold in your life?

How would that help you bring some good to each moment, something better to each day, and your best to each other as you encounter the world around you? Start by considering these questions:

- First, wrestle with the identity question: **Who am I?**
- Second, think about how the resurrection reframes your purpose:
Ask yourself: **What am I doing here?**
- Third, ask the vision question: **Where am I going?**
- Finally: **What's my mission? How will I get there?**

Keep your answers in mind as we explore thriving rhythms in the weeks to come!
