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See It

Every time you eat a meal this week, look at the cup of whatever you have been given to drink. Remember that Jesus gives us living water that lasts forever!



Hear It

Jesus told the woman at the well about everything she had ever done. Ask family members to share their favorite stories about you.



Talk About It

1. Talk about a time you were VERY thirsty. What were you doing that made you so thirsty? How did you feel when you were thirsty? How did you feel after you had a drink?
2. Is there somebody you know who is very different from you? What can you do to show them kindness and get to know them better?
3. What is something new you recently learned? What are some things you can do to learn more about Jesus?
4. Share about a time you were so excited about something that you could hardly wait to tell others about it.



Live It

For families to do together: Take a long walk together. As you walk, talk about everything you see, hear, feel, and smell. Imagine you are travelling all the way to the next town on foot. When you get home, drink a big glass of water. How does the water taste? How would living water compare to it?

For pre-k kids: Ask family members to tell you stories about some of the things they did when they were your age. As you hear their stories, think about how Jesus knew everything about the woman at the well even though he had never met her before.

Dear Jesus, thank you for giving us living water. Thank you for loving us, for forgiving us, and for making it possible for us to live forever with God! Thank you for loving everybody and for offering everybody living water. Amen.



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
