ONSITE SUMMER CAMPS

VBS CREW LEADERS AND CO-LEADERS

June 23 – 26, 2025 | Commit to four days plus prep time | Background check for 18+

Spend a week exploring Bible stories with the kids! Crew co-leaders assist the crew leaders as they guide children through activities like crafts, snacks, games, science projects, music/arts, and more! Maintain a safe, engaged, fun and relational atmosphere. Minimum age for co-leaders: completed 6th grade. Minimum age for crew leaders: completed 9th grade or proven leadership and competency.

VBS STATION HELPERS AND LEADERS

June 23 – 26, 2025 | Commit to four days plus prep time

Help kids dive deeper into classic Bible stories through fun activities. Station leaders present the provided VBS script multiple times during the morning station rotations. Station helpers assist station leaders with set up and clean up each day, and might be asked to help with advance prep work. Content for station leaders and helpers, as well as preparation time, varies depending on the chosen station. POP staff will assist as needed.

WORSHIP ARTS CAMP CREW LEADERS AND CO-LEADERS

July 28 – 31, 2025 | Commit to four days plus prep time | Background check for 18+

Help kids make friends, explore Bible stories, build confidence, and discover their artistic gifts. Crew leaders supervise a group of 8 children, guiding them through various activities. Co-leaders assist the crew leaders. Maintain a safe, engaged, fun and relational atmosphere. Minimum age for a co-leader: completed 6th grade. Minimum age for a crew leader: completed 9th grade or proven leadership experience and competency.

CHILDCARE ASSISTANT

Sat/Sun/Wed | Other dates as needed | Background check for 18+

Provide care for our congregation's youngest children while their grown-ups are engaged in worship or other Prince of Peace activities. Help childcare staff as directed, engage in age appropriate play, monitor activity to ensure that children are playing safely and respectfully and help with snacks. We'd prefer a weekly or bi-weekly commitment for this role.

POP KIDS – Kindergarten through Grade 5

Sunday mornings | Wednesday evenings | September – April | Background check for 18+

SMALL GROUP LEADER: Lead a grade-level-based small group in activities and discussion supporting the weekly Bible story. Curriculum guides, discussion prompts and materials are provided. Begin with 10 minutes of small group time and then all grades gather for worship. The final 20 minutes are spent continuing small group activities. Volunteers can be bi-weekly.

1:1 COMPANION: Make sure ALL children can participate in POP Kids in ways that are comfortable and meaningful for them. Support a specific child's participation by providing opportunities for them to access sensory tools or take a sensory/movement break when needed. Volunteers can be bi-weekly.

ROOM SUPERVISOR: Monitor the chapel space during POP Kids to ensure safety, proper energy levels and appropriate behavior. Assist group leaders if they need to escort a child to the restroom. Intermittent volunteers are welcome!

TECH BOOTH SUPERVISOR: Help run worship tech and inspire kids to learn worship tech skills. Supervise 1-2 students (grades 4-12) in the tech booth. An intuitive sense for computer applications is beneficial, but POP staff will provide training for you so that you can train and assist the students. We use ProPresenter software for the screens, a computerized light board, a computerized sound board, microphones and automated window shades.

PRAISE CHOIR – Kindergarten through Grade 5

September – April | Background check for 18+

PRAISE CHOIR BACKSTAGE ASSISTANT: Assist with props, costumes, microphones, entrances/exits, and maintaining quiet, appropriate behavior backstage. Commitment: Sunday afternoons/select evenings during musical worship week

PRAISE CHOIR REHEARSAL ASSISTANT: Assist with supervision of children during breaks, read lines for absent actors and help with line memorization. Responsibilities may vary based on the volunteer's age and experience. Minimum age: completed 7th grade. Commitment: Sunday afternoons, select evenings during musical worship weekend.

SET CONSTRUCTION: Assist with the creation of sets and props for Christmas and spring productions, Vacation Bible School, Worship Arts Camp or monthly programming series. Carpentry, painting, cutting and taping are the primary needs.

CONFIRMATION – Grades 6-8

Wednesday evenings | September – April | Background check for 18+

SMALL GROUP LEADER | 3 - 7 YEAR COMMITMENTS PREFERRED | Remain with the same group as they grow

Help POP students build community and grow in faith. Lead a grade based small group in activities/discussion supporting the weekly Confirmation content. Curriculum guides, discussion prompts and all materials are provided. Communicate regularly with parents, may supervise service project and/or special event participation.

STUDENT MINISTRY – Grades 9-12

Wednesday evenings | September – April | Background check for 18+

SMALL GROUP LEADER | 4-YEAR COMMITMENT: Help students build community and grow in faith. Lead a grade-based small group in activities and discussion supporting the weekly topic. Curriculum guides, discussion prompts and all materials are provided. Begin with 10 minutes of small group time and then all grades gather for worship. The final 30-45 minutes are spent in small groups. Small group leaders communicate regularly with parents and may supervise service projects and/or special event participation.

GAMES COORDINATOR: Help students engage and build community. Lead students in low-level physical activities like relays or mental games like trivia that encourage relationship building. Intermittent volunteers are welcome.

PIZZA SALES

Wednesday evenings | September – April | Background check for 18+

Provide food and hospitality for Wednesday night programming. Sell and serve slices of Davanni's pizza to students, families and leaders on-site for evening ministry programs. Refill lemonade dispenser if needed. Minimal clean up at the end of the evening includes wiping tables and running the dishwasher. Training is provided. Intermittent volunteers are welcome.

ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

HOSPITALITY: Provide faithful hospitality to kids and families at Prince of Peace. Assist with food and beverage service during special events such as first communion, confirmation celebration, end of year parties, etc. Commitment varies.

KEEPING THE PROMISE SUPPORT: Assist with preparing and setting up materials that support the Keeping the Promise family experiences each month. Intermittent volunteers are welcome!

SEWING: Use sewing skills to create Musical costumes and keepsake items. Projects vary from easy stitching to advanced level. Examples include first communion stoles, costumes for the spring musical, and set decor using fabric.

CRAFT PROJECT PLANNER FOR EVENTS (Great ADVENTure, EGGstravaganza, etc): Plan meaningful crafts that bring Bible stories to life. Gather and prep materials for age-appropriate crafts connected to event themes. Input and suggestions for crafts are appreciated. Be on-site the day of the event if possible to direct additional volunteers hosting the craft stations.
