WORSHIP TEAM

Make music with us! A short vocal or instrumental interview is required—no pressure, we just want to hear you sing or play.

Weekly worship team commitments include: practice at home (1 hour); midweek rehearsal (1 hour); and serving at the 5:30pm Saturday or 10:30am Sunday service (2–3 hours). Worship team members serve 2–4 times/month based on team rotation. Sign up for a 4-month term: January–April (includes Easter); May–August; or September–December (includes Christmas Eve).

LEAD VOCALIST: Lead the congregation in worship through singing. Must be spiritually prepared, attend rehearsals, learn music in advance, and lead at least one song during a scheduled service.

BACKGROUND VOCALIST: Support lead vocalists with harmonies and vocal blend. Must be able to blend vocally, follow direction, and lead worship off-mic.

INSTRUMENTALIST: Play an instrument in the worship band. Must be prepared, attend rehearsals, and arrive early for sound check.

PRODUCTION TEAM

Work behind the scenes to make online and in-person worship experiences flow smoothly.

AUDIO ENGINEER (Front of House and Livestream): Mix sound for live worship and streaming. Must have an ear for music and attention to detail. Training is provided. MEDIA / PRO PRESENTER OPERATOR: Operate ProPresenter for lyrics, sermon slides, and videos. Ideal for detail-oriented and tech-minded volunteers. commitments include midweek rehearsal (1 hour) and weekend worship (3–4 hours), with shifts 1–2 times per month. SERVICE PRODUCER / STAGE MANAGER: Oversee the flow of the service and coordinate cues between worship, teaching, and tech teams.
