Who We Are: Prince of Peace Lutheran Church (POP), is an ELCA congregation of 5,600 members located in the southern Twin Cities suburb of Burnsville, MN. At our core we seek to see the Gospel transform lives. We do this through providing robust mission opportunities through our onsite food shelf and dental clinic, providing thought provoking sermon series, traditional and contemporary worship geared for excellence, and learning and personal growth opportunities for all ages.

Job Summary: The Staff Accompanist and Organist will support Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in its mission and ministry through exceptional musical leadership from the piano and organ. The Staff Accompanist and Organist will participate in weekly worship services, accompany the choir in weekly rehearsals, and provide music for funerals and weddings as needed.

Essential Artistic Functions

- Play organ/piano for the weekly Classic Service (9 am). This will include: Providing musical preludes and a postlude on piano and/or organ.
- Accompanying 2-4 congregational hymns.
- Accompanying musical liturgy.
- Provide music during the offering as needed.
- Provide accompaniment for the Prince of Peace Celebration Choir.
- Serve as rehearsal accompanist for the Prince of Peace Celebration Choir (Thursdays @ 6:30 pm)
- Lead sectionals for the Prince of Peace Celebration Choir.
- Accompany additional services and events that include: Prince of Peace Christmas Concerts
- (Christmas ,Maundy Thursday, Good Friday , Easter)
- Being the on-call accompanist for funerals and weddings (with an additional stipend).

Administrative Functions

- Maintain the piano and organ library.
- Schedule weekly practice sessions.
- Coordinate substitutes if absent from rehearsals or services.

- Provide titles of music to the Worship Arts Executive Assistant.
- Pursue ongoing professional development and training opportunities.
- Assist the Director of Music Ministries in envisioning and shaping the future of music ministry at Prince of Peace.
