



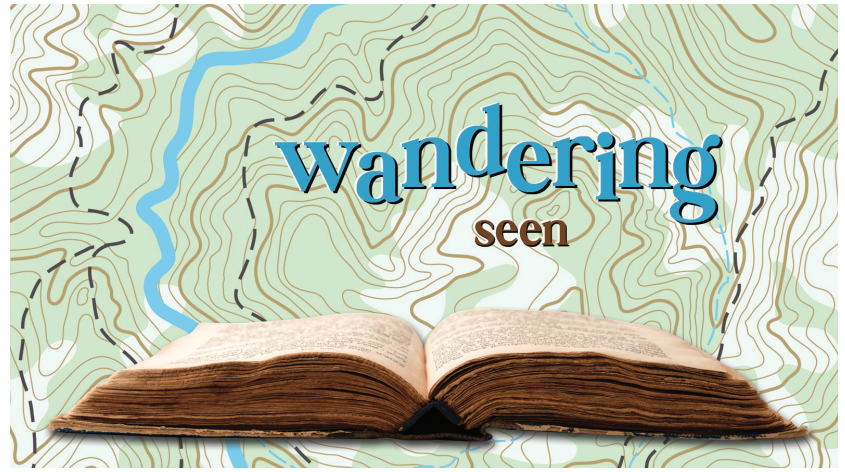

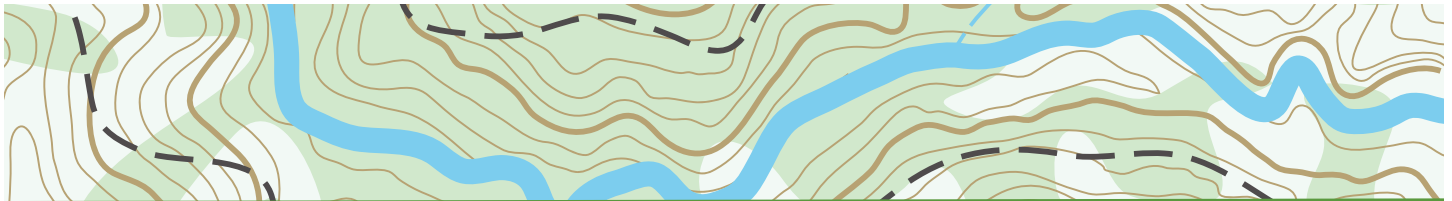
Terri Elton – author, pastor, and professor of leadership at Luther Seminary – will be the speaker at this event for all the leaders in the Prince of Peace community.

Holy Imagination

The daughters of Zelophehad knew something wasn't right. They were trying to figure out how they could continue to live in and contribute to their community when the commonly accepted rules were pushing them out. They were able to imagine a better situation. Their imaginations were one way God worked to shape the people into a more holy and just community.

If we give ourselves a moment, all of us can imagine one or several ways that our own communities could better reflect the heart of God. Could our imaginations also be an avenue for God to shape us and our world?

Today, let's practice offering our imaginations to the work of the Lord. There are a variety of ways to approach it but if you're new to this, here are some ideas:

Settle yourself in a comfortable place without distractions.

In prayer, dedicate the time to Jesus, listening, asking, and resting in him.

Breathe deeply and slowly. Feel the effect of the breath moving through your body.

*Mentally scan your body, noticing anything that doesn't feel right or is bothering you.
Offer these things to the Holy Spirit's care.*

*Imagine Jesus is with you. Visualize his eyes, hair, expression. Is he sitting or standing beside you?
Get as detailed as possible.*

Looking into Jesus' eyes, what do you imagine he would like you to know?

What would you like to tell him?

Stay in this moment as long as possible. Let your heart communicate with Jesus.

When the moment passes, bring your awareness back to your body. Continue to breathe deeply.

Thank Jesus for sharing the moment with you.

Reflect on the experience. Journal about it, draw a picture, or continue the conversation in prayer. How is Jesus inviting you to experience new life? How is Jesus inviting you to share this new life in your community?
