Who is your angel?

Where do you see angels in your life? In Jesus' time, angels were heralds and protectors. They were life-giving. Angels were also believed to be very strong and war-like. Some were even depicted as part human, part lion and other powerful creatures. While we may see angels differently today, they are still present among us. Do we see them?

This week you are invited to reflect on the angels in your life, and the opportunities you have to be an angel in other people's lives. When you think of angels, think of those who have:

COME WITH GOOD NEWS – as the angel brought good news to Mary announcing Jesus birth.

COME WITH WARNINGS – as the angel warned Joseph to flee with his family.

MINISTER TO US – as an angel brought healing to Jesus in the wilderness.

TO GIVE US STRENGTH – as an angel appeared to Jesus before his death.

TO REVEAL GOD'S LOVE – as an angel rolled the stone away from the tomb.
