Seven Days of Hope & Healing

Does everything feel heavy these days? Here is a week of breath prayers, scripture readings and spiritual practices designed to move you through the coming week.

SUNDAY – GOD IS NEAR

Psalm 34:18 – “The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit.”

Breathe in: “You are near.” **Breathe out:** “I am not alone.”

Spiritual Practice: Text one person – “Thinking of you. How can I pray for you?”

MONDAY – PEACE FOR ANXIOUS HEARTS

Philippians 4:6-7 – “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

Breathe in: “Give me peace.” **Breathe out:** “Guard my mind.”

Spiritual Practice: Inhale for four counts, exhale for six counts. Repeat for two minutes.

TUESDAY – STRENGTH FOR TODAY

Isaiah 41:10 – “Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God; I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will uphold you with my victorious right hand.”

Breathe in: “Strength for now.” **Breathe out:** “Grace for today.”

Spiritual Practice: Write down three small, do-able things you can do today.

WEDNESDAY – COURAGE

2 Timothy 1:7 – “For God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline.”

Breathe in: “Spirit of power.” **Breathe out:** “Spirit of Love.”

Spiritual Practice: Take one “next right step” you’ve been avoiding.

THURSDAY – COMFORT

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 – “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and the God of all consolation, who consoles us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to console those who are in any affliction with the consolation with which we ourselves are consoled by God.

Breathe in: “God of comfort.” **Breathe out:** “Hold us.”

Spiritual Practice: Light a candle at home and pray for the city by name.

FRIDAY – LOVE FOR NEIGHBORS

Romans 12:18 – “If it is possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all.”

Breathe in: “Make me kind.” **Breathe out:** “Make me brave.”

Spiritual Practice: Do one quiet, anonymous act of help.

SATURDAY – HOPE

Romans 15:13 – “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit..”

Breathe in: “God of hope.” **Breathe out:** “Fill us.”

Spiritual Practice: Choose one ongoing rhythm: prayer, serving, giving, or small group.
