



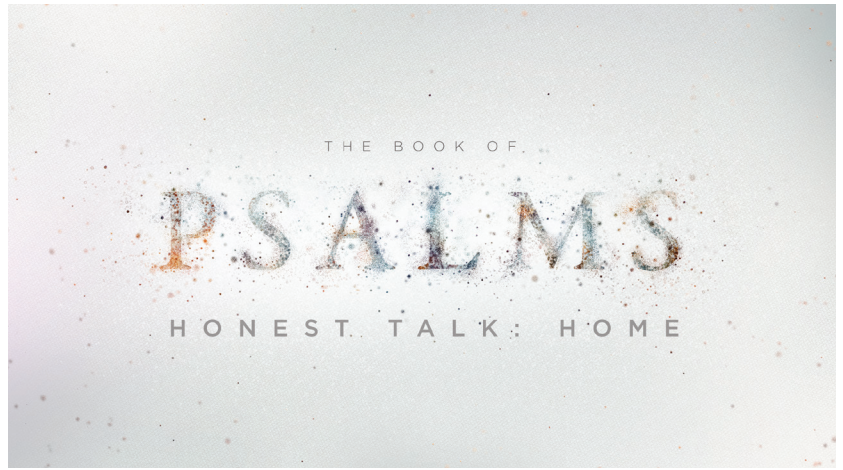

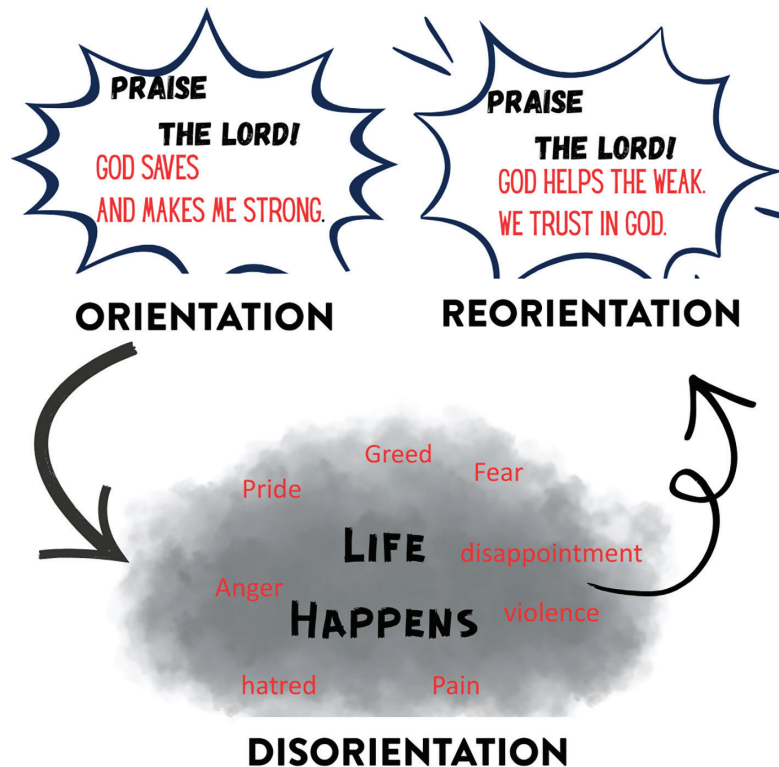

As we begin our new worship series on the Psalms, let's dig a bit deeper into understanding them. Theologian Walter Brueggemann created a way of categorizing the Psalms and bringing them into our own personal lives. He believes that we regularly find ourselves in one of three categories at any given time in our lives:

- **ORIENTATION** – in which everything makes sense in our lives
- **DISORIENTATION** – in which we feel we have sunk into the pit
- **REORIENTATION** – new orientation – in which we realize that God has lifted us out of the pit and we are in a new place full of gratitude and awareness about our lives and our God.



Psalm 8 is a creation psalm and hymn of praise. It begs the question, “Who Am I?” Marveling at all the splendor of God’s creation, we seem rather small in it all. But this psalm places us just below God. It tells us that God sees us as significant to what God is doing in this world.

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

Have you ever felt insignificant in this world?

What changes in you when you understand God’s place for you and humans?

What are ways you can participate more in God’s created world?

How do you care for creation?
