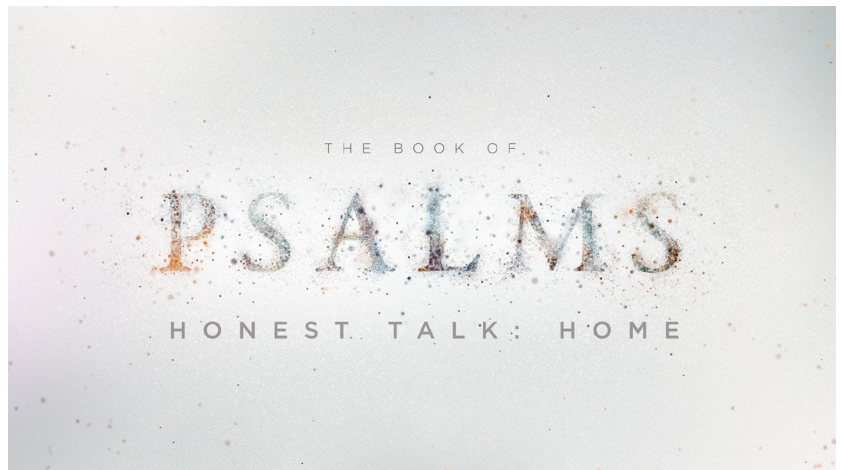

## DOES GOD REWARD AND PUNISH?

We spend a lot of time trying to discern our potential rewards or punishments for the things we do in life, both on the human level and in relationship to the divine. What does this transactional behavior say about our culture, and the way we see each other and the world? Do potential rewards and punishments inform every decision we make?

Have you ever done anything really generous without expecting either a human or “heavenly” reward of any kind? How did that feel?

Is there room in a capitalist society for unbridled generosity? Does pure benevolence appear counter-cultural, careless, suspicious? Why, or why not?

Is the triumph of the good, as it’s written in Psalm 112, a divine reward? Is the melting away of the wicked a divine punishment? Was the world created in such a way that generosity, hospitality, welcome and community will bring transcendence and joy, while violence and a lack of compassion will eventually fail? Are natural consequences enough of an incentive for us with open hand and hearts? Or do we need more?

Is the world still created “good” when there are casualties along the path towards justice, when evil feels like it’s winning?
