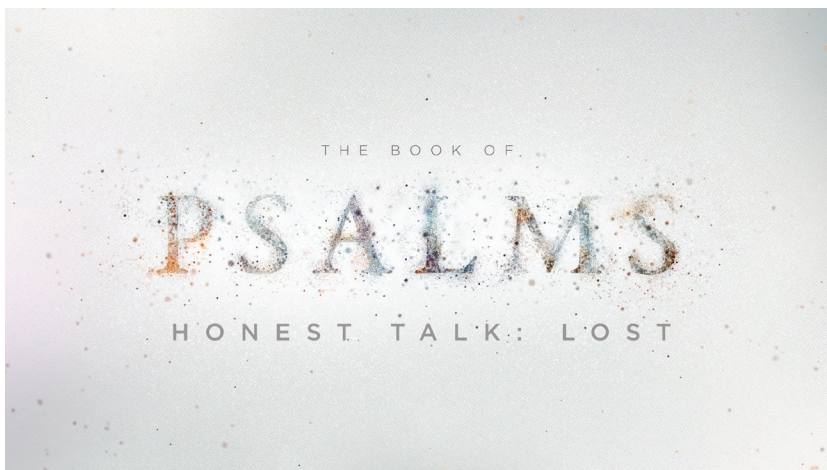

LAMENT

Psalm 74 doesn't resolve its own questions. It ends still waiting. Where in your life are you still asking "How long, O God?" without an answer yet in sight?

The psalmist's questions in verses 10-11 come from people who have lost the temple, the king, and the prophets, yet they still address God directly. What does it look like for you to keep speaking to God when evidence of God's presence feels thin?

The Hebrew word for mercy is tied to the sensation of guts twisted up in pain. Have you experienced someone else's pain in your own body? When have you felt that others legitimately shared your pain?

History rhymes: the temple was destroyed twice, generations apart, and the same cries returned in new form. What crisis in your own life or your community feels like an old grief resurfacing in a new shape?

The sermon connects lament to remembering and caring for those the world overlooks, the sick, the poor, the suffering. Who is someone in your circle right now that needs you to remember them and remind them they're worthy of love?
