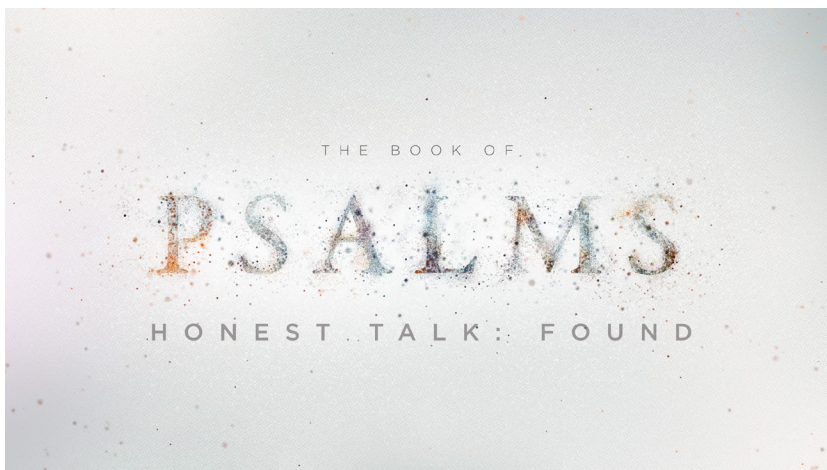

INVITATION

This hymn, attributed to King David, mixes faithful relationship with the reality of human failure. God is approachable. God is forgiving. God is seeking relationships with all of us, even with the earth itself. This is an invitation to a deeper relationship with God, to us and to those we invite on the journey.

The Message translation of Psalm 65 includes these words: “We all arrive at your doorstep sooner or later, loaded with guilt.” What guilt do you carry with you? Look back over your life through that lens. Think back on specific times when you made mistakes – big ones. What happened?

Were you, and your mistakes, met with contempt or grace? Were you able to change, or grow? Were relationships mended? Why, or why not? If you were met with grace, how did that feel? If you were not met with grace, how did that feel? How does God meet the writer of this psalm?

What happens when mistakes are met with expansive love? Notice how quickly this writer’s perspective shifts from lament to a sense of wonder that’s as wide as the whole world, as tall as the mountains and as wild as the waves. Do you think the concept of forgiveness actually widens our perspective? Do we see more clearly through the lens of love and forgiveness?

How does gratitude factor in to this psalm? Is gratitude hard-wired into a world that is teeming with forgiveness and new life? Why?

Why do we choose to live in the darkness of personal guilt and shame, and of communal blame and anger, when we are surrounded by extravagant, divine grace and love? What is it that keeps us thinking so small?

Here’s what you can expect in the coming weeks:

Starting the week of September 14, we’ll send out emails inviting you to create your log-in to Realm Connect. We’ll send them via our database in batches using the alphabet breakdown below.

Our list of emails does not pull from the same platform as our POP Five weekly emails. Just because you receive the POP Five does not necessarily mean we have your email correct in our primary database. This process will help us identify email addresses that need to be updated within Realm.

Once you’re logged in, be sure to update your photo and privacy settings. In order to access the online directory, you must “opt in” within Realm Connect.
